Zero Relative Pronouns

• There's a certain beauty in your resistance, but it's a beauty (that) we can't afford.



• I'm gonna walk myself back to the woman (whom) my mother thought I was.




'm gonna walk myself back to the womar [whom] my mother thought I was.

Examples:

- 1) The movie that/which/zero he recommended was a good one.
- 2) The woman whom/zero I hired to look after my mother is wonderful.
- 3) Lucy is the one who introduced Tom to me.
- 4) This is the man whom/zero I saw in the bank yesterday.
- 5) The house that/which/zero I bought last year has been destroyed by the fire.
- 6) We all saw the movie that/which won the Oscar Award this year.
- 7) I disagreed with most of the points that/which/zero she raised.
- 8) The men who renovated our house did a wonderful job.
- 9) Jack is the boy with whom Jenny fell in love.
- **10)** My grandfather built the house that/which/zero I was born in.

Reduced Relative Clauses

• The guy (who is) on the ground is wrong. The last man (who is) standing up is always right.



Examples:

1) Reduce to a Prepositional Phrase

The box that was on the table was made in Italy. Reduced \rightarrow The box on the table was made in Italy.

The woman who was at the meeting spoke about business in Europe. Reduced \rightarrow The woman at the meeting spoke about business in Europe.

2) Reduce to an Adjective Phrase

The man who is interested in your car will call later. Reduced \rightarrow The man interested in your car will call later.

The product, which seemed perfect in many ways, failed to succeed in the market. Reduced \rightarrow The product, perfect in many ways, failed to succeed in the market.

3) Reduce to a Present Participle Phrase

Who is the girl who is sitting next to your brother? Reduced \rightarrow Who is the girl sitting next to your brother?

The dog that is lying on the floor won't get up. Reduced \rightarrow The dog lying on the floor won't get up.

The man who lives near my home walks to work every day. Reduced \rightarrow The man living near my home walks to work every day.

Anyone who enters the garden without permission will be punished. Reduced \rightarrow Anyone entering the garden without permission will be punished.

4) Reduce to a Past Participle Phrase

The elephant which was born in captivity was set free. Reduced \rightarrow The elephant born in captivity was set free.

Most people who were invited to the party didn't turn up. Reduced \rightarrow Most people invited to the party didn't turn up.

Yesterday I read a book that was written by Jane Austen. Reduced \rightarrow Yesterday I read a book written by Jane Austen.

A person who has been tricked once is careful the next time. Reduced \rightarrow A person tricked once is careful the next time.
